- (i) Article 4.8 of the MSAA concerning applicable procurement practices;
- (ii) The Connecting Care Act, 2019; and
- (iii) Any compensation restraint legislation which applies to the Hospital

Appendix 1 – Exceptions

1. The Hospital has not achieved an Annual Balanced Budget as is required as a condition of funding in the MSAA. A deficit of \$33,723 was reported as a result of Bill 124 arbitration awards not being specifically connected to the fund types that were impacted. The revenue was fully recognized as Fund 1 revenue in accordance with the Ministry directive, therefore not offsetting related Fund 2 expenses and resulting in this exception to compliance.
