Since mental health issues, like physical problems, affect most of us at some point in our lives, it is our goal to have services available in your community.

Our service supports individuals with mental health problems to enhance their coping skills and improve their quality of life.

Our service is available, on a voluntary basis, to adults age 16 and over with priority given to the seriously mentally ill.

Services Available Include:

- Goal oriented treatment plans developed with each individual
- Treatment and therapy groups
- Skill based educational groups
- Social and recreational groups
- Individual counselling

The length of involvement with our service depends on individual need.
